Guidelines for English Language Course

Important Instructions for foreign students for getting admission into English course

1. The minimum qualifications to register English course is 10+2 or High School or grade 12 or Equivalent or more.
2. **Note:** You will not be allowed for final admission without the original certificates. Every student has to bring High School Certificate along with other certificates.
3. Report immediately at the University Foreign Relations Office, JNT University on arrival at Hyderabad, after obtaining valid student visa.
4. Pay Tuition fee as mentioned in the Provisional Admission Letter and ID card fee of Rs.100/- through challan.
5. After receiving the Final Admission Letter from this office, obtain Bonafide certificate from DUFR and register immediately with the Foreign Regional Registration Office (FRRO), Hyderabad for Residential Permit.
6. If the students are unable to attend class work within one week period of classes commencement of particular batch, they have to wait for the next batch or they can forgo admission.
7. The medium of Instruction in JNTUH is English. All the students are therefore expected to have Proficiency in English.
8. No transfers from one college to another shall be entertained under any circumstances.
9. Limited Hostel facility is available to foreign students at International students Hostel (ISH) within the university campus based vacancies available in ISH. Interested students may apply for the hostel at the time of final admission subjected to agreement of Rules and Regulations of ISH.
10. Registration fee will not be refunded. Once tuition fee paid will not be refunded.
11. Registration into English Language course is not guarantee to take admission into JNTUH-ELT.
12. No student should pressurize the DUFR for their late admission in to these English Language courses by him/her and respective Embassies/Consulates.
13. If the student misbehaves during the course period, admission may be cancelled, without giving any information to the respective embassies.
14. At the end of the course the student has to pass the exam conducted by DUFR to get JNTUH-ELT examination.
15. Every student should have minimum of 75% of attendance to attend JNTUH-ELT exam. However minimum of 65% + medical certificate in case of student hospitalized.
16. If the attendance is below 65%, no candidate will be allowed to write JNTUH-ELT exam and will not get certificate.

Official Processing Time at DUFR

- The Preparation of Provisional Admission Letter (PAL) will take 3 Working Days.
- No Change of Course duration or Renewal of PAL.
- The Preparation of Bonafide certificate will take 4 working days.
